

**Pruritic papules and Nodules as Sign of Persistent Scabies Infestation Despite Treatment According to Current Guidelines
Evidence for Treatment Resistance to Ivermectin, Benzylbenzoat, and Permethrin Proven by Videomicroscopy**

Scabies infestation is a growing public health problem with increasing incidence in many countries. Here we report for the first time proof of treatment resistance to permethrin, ivermectin and benzylbenzoat. Therefore, persisting scabies infestation should be treated with a broadened therapeutical regimen, including crotamitex, which finally leads to an effective treatment with cure of the scabies infestation.
